SECTION III - PHYSICAL AND HEALTH HAZARD DATA

Eye Contact : May cause moderate eye irritation. Symptoms include stinging, tearing, and redness.

Skin Contact : Prolonged or repeated exposure may cause slight skin irritation. A single prolonged exposure is not likely to result in the material being absorbed through skin in harmful amounts.

Swallowing : Not expected to result in harmful effects.

Inhalation : May cause irritation of the nose and throat, accompanied by cough and chest pain, if mist or dust is inhaled.

Other Potential Health Risks : Prolonged exposure to aluminum oxide dust can cause pneumoconiosis.

Target Organ Effects : Overexposure to propylene glycol has been suggested as a cause of the following effects in laboratory animals, and may aggravate pre-existing disorders of these organs in humans: kidney damage.
